

Snow Response Plan – 2023/2024

The Kilmington Parish Snow Response Plan is designed to provide a co-ordinated response during, and after, periods of intense snow fall, with the aim of keeping primary and secondary roads open, providing residents with access to the B3092 and A303.

In the event of heavy snow fall:

Wiltshire Council Highway's Department will clear the B3092 as a priority.

When required, Mr. Ian Meeker will be employed by Wiltshire Council to clear secondary routes within the parish with tractor/snow blade.

Salt spreading should only be undertaken when prompted by Wiltshire Council during or just before a snow event. The supplied salt is not for precautionary salting use throughout the winter.

The Parish Council is unable to clear, salt or grit the local highway but will hand out salt to private individuals on a self-help basis on the understanding that it is **not to be used on private paths and driveways**. Salt in the form of 25kg bags will be available to collect from the following Parish Councillors:
